

# ARTWORK PREPARATION FOR PRINT



The red line is the external bleed margin. All background images, colours, patterns and artwork elements that touch the trim edge must also extend to the external bleed margin. This should be at least 3mm from the trim edge.

The black line is the trim edge. This is the line along which your printing will be trimmed or cut.

The magenta line is the internal bleed margin. All text, logos and important graphics must be kept within the internal bleed margin. Any text or images that extend beyond the internal bleed margin risk being trimmed or cut off during finishing. This should be a minimum of 5mm from the trim edge.

#### Internal Bleed

Make sure all your text and logos are within the internal bleed margin, otherwise they may be trimmed off.

## **External Bleed**

Make sure all backgrounds / elements that meet the trim edge extend to the edge of the external bleed line so you won't have any white edges.

## **Artwork Size**

Make sure your design is the right size or it may be automatically resized which may distort your artwork.

## **Border Width**

Make sure all borders are at least 5mm from the trim edge to avoid any uneven borders.

## **Image Resolution**

Make sure all images are 300dpi and rasterized text is150dpi when placed at 100% so they won't look blurry or pixilated when printed. If possible save as CMYK .tif format before placement.

#### **Fonts**

Ensure all fonts are embedded correctly or even better ... outlined. Problems can occur if a font is included which is not licensed to embed.

### **PDF**

We prefer print ready PDF files with bleed and trim marks.
